Also, we will assign the length and axle configuration in section two, as per the finished unit requires.

Section three we will assign the year code as D(1983), E(1984) and F(1985) as the first character.

We will assign the second character as our plant number - **1 = SPRINGVILLE, AL.** The third through the eighth characters, we will assign as the trailer serial number.
