REGISTRATION AS FINAL STAGE MANUFACTURER

Pursuant to the requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 49, section 566, the DynCorp Tri-Cities Services, Inc., Transportation & Waste Handling organization would like to establish registration with the Administration as a final stage manufacturer. DynCorp is a subcontractor to the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (DOE-RL), and all work is done on equipment owned by DOE-RL, the General Services Administration, or other government entities. No work is done for the private sector.

DynCorp has replaced ICF Kaiser Hanford Company as the Hanford Site fleet maintenance organization and has assumed all the responsibilities as defined in 49 CFR 566. As of October 1, 1996, ICF Kaiser Hanford Company is no longer a DOE-RL Hanford Site subcontractor.

- Trailers: Drop deck, flatbed, and van trailers. Make repairs, add landing gear, tiedowns, tail lifts, etc., and redeck.
- Cargo Tank Motor Vehicles: DOT 306, 406, 407. Transfer used tanks to new cab-chassis.
- Passenger Vehicles: Cars, pickups, vans, and cargo vans. Addition of tail lifts, racks, and equipment for use as service vehicles and for use by patrol and fire departments.
