Twisted which will be labeled as : T

Eight Ball which be labeled as: E

Moonsaw which will be labeled as: M

Spear which will be labeled as: P

Lonesome Road also plans on manufacturing a more traditional or common style framed motor cycle including both a "single " or "double" downtube style frame.

These frames have no name and will be labeled with a G, meaning generic, in place of the S,T,E,M&P for position # 4.

All frames produced by Lonesome Road Choppers will come in both a "Rigid" or "Hardtail" and as well as a "Softail" version.

The softail will carry the # 1 in the # 5 position

The hardtail or rigid will carry the # 2 in the # 5 position
